## Equipment

- South Craven School and Steeton Cricket Club will provide all necessary equipment

## Conditions

- Each school shall play each other in the Kwik Cricket format for junior cricket;
- Each school squad shall comprise 10 players, including a minimum of two girls, with each team on the pitch comprising 8 players, with at least one girl included;
- Batting team bat in pairs starting with 200 runs;
- Fielding team have one bowler and one wicket keeper, three on/ leg-side fielders; three off-side fielders;
- Fielders rotate position after each over;
- Batting pairs receives two six-ball overs, good balls only are counted - wides do not count;
- If a bowled ball passes outside either cone placed to the left and right of the wicket, a 'wide' is called and the batter receive one run and an extra ball is bowled;
- Batting pairs change after 12 good balls;
- Boundaries score four runs only. Batters lose five runs each time they are bowled, caught, run out or hit wicket; and
- Winners are the team with most runs when every pair has batted
